

Stuffed Squid

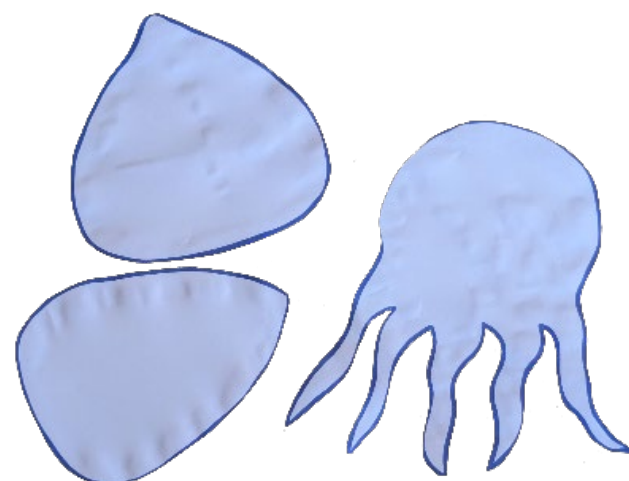
You Need:

- Template from page 3
- Cardboard for template
- Coloured paper
- Goggle eyes

- Scissors
- Textas or crayons
- Coloured dots

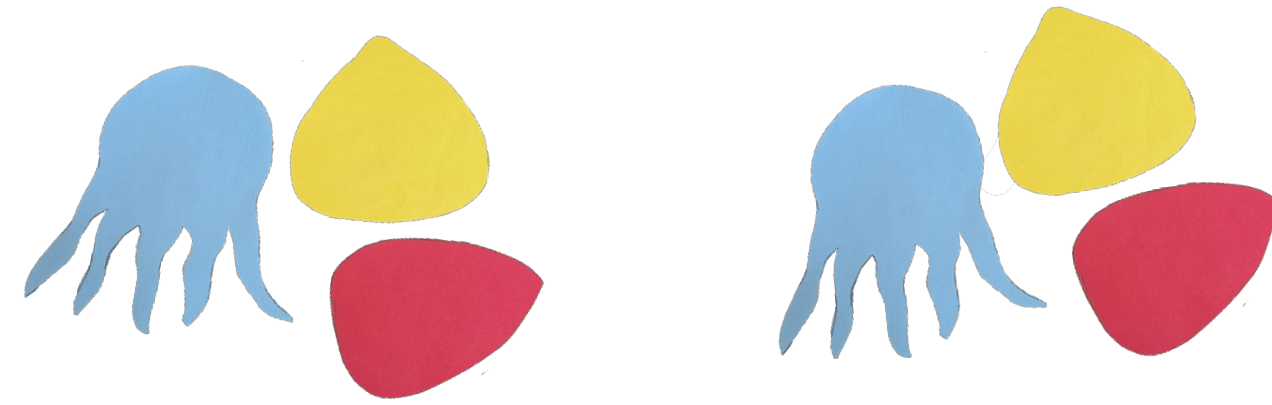
Adult:

1. Print out the template
2. Glue to the card
3. Let dry
4. Cut out the shapes
5. These shapes become the template pieces your child traces around



Instructions for child:

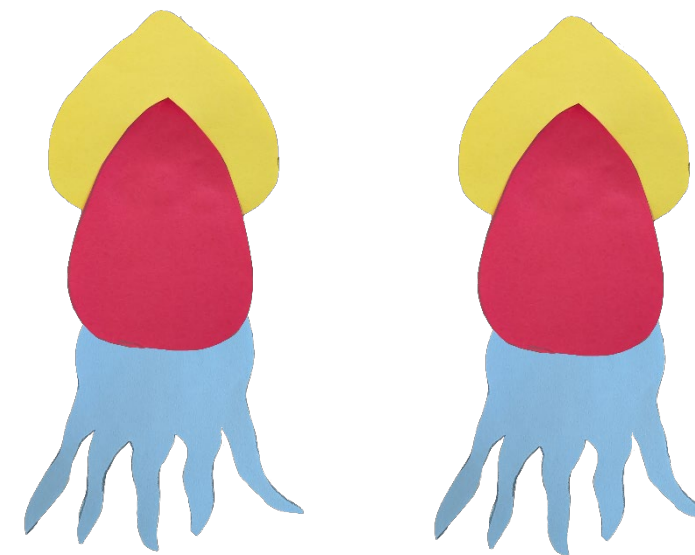
1. Trace and cut out two of each shape.



2. Glue each trunk to a fin.



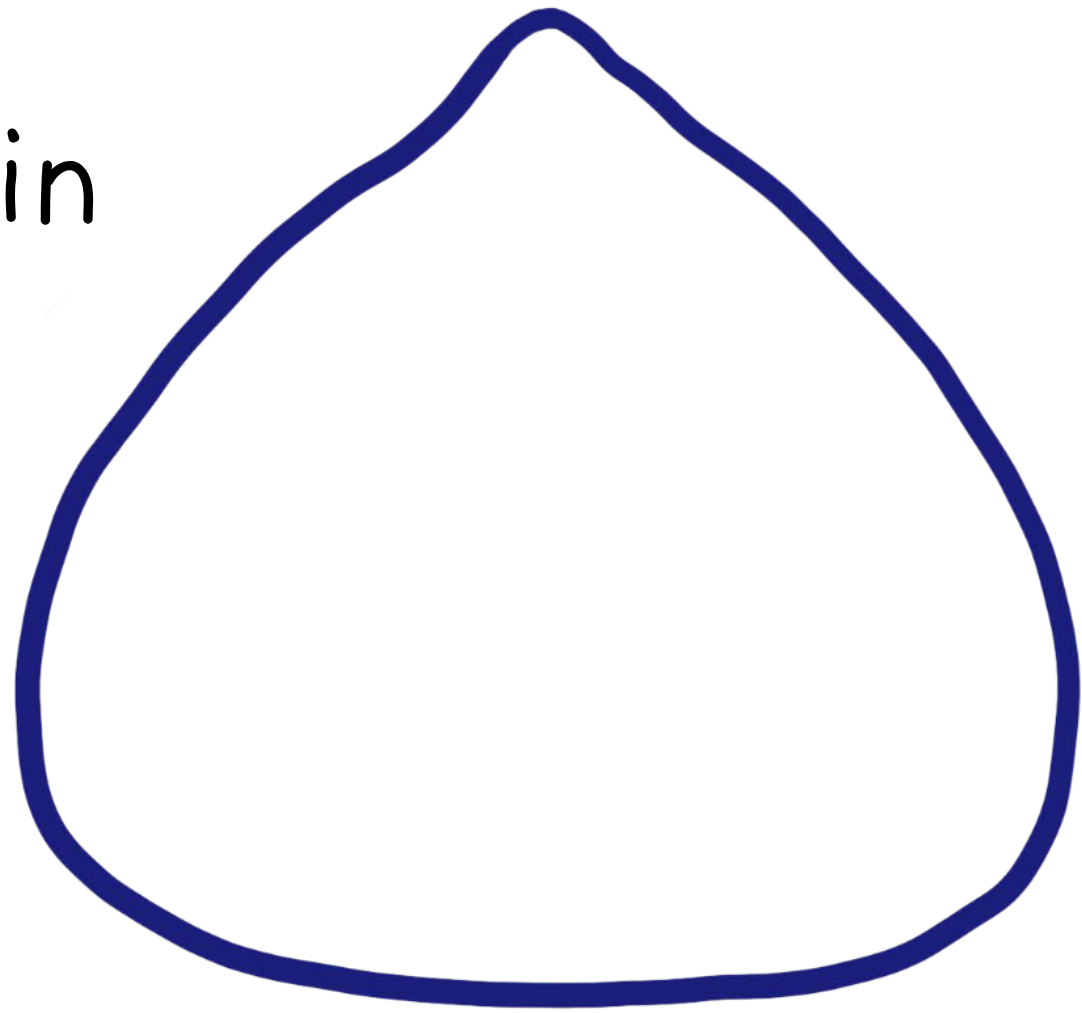
3. Glue each head to a trunk.



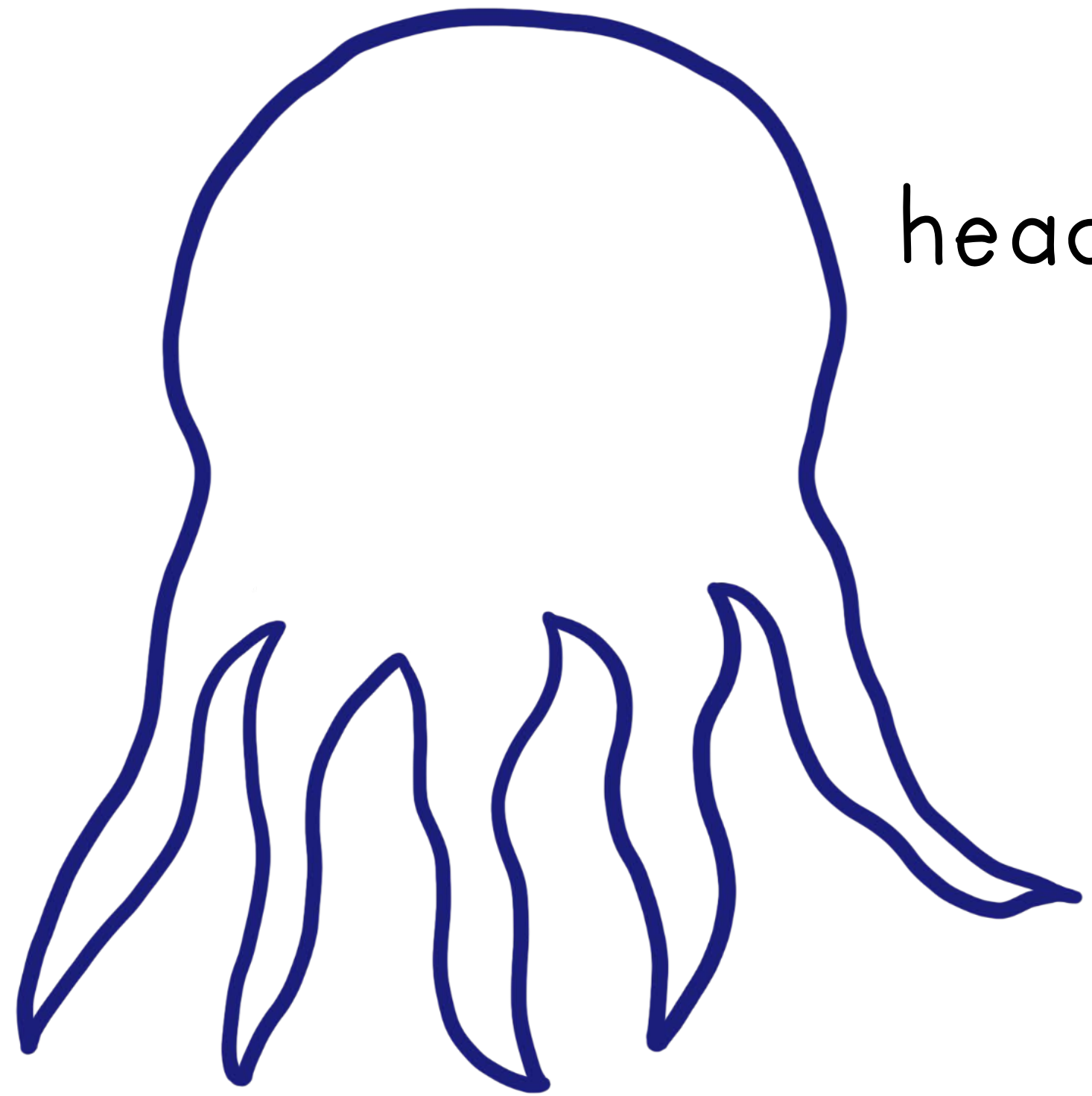
4. When these are dry, carefully drizzle glue around the edge on one head, trunk and fin. Carefully glue the second set onto this (make sure the shapes match as they are not a mirror image). Leave the bottom open.
5. When this is dry, carefully stuff the squid with small pieces of paper until you can't put anymore in. Glue across the bottom inside section of the squid and press both sides together until they stick.
6. Once dry, add eyes and mouth on one side. Add coloured dots to decorate.
7. Hang with string or hang on the wall with Blue Tack.
