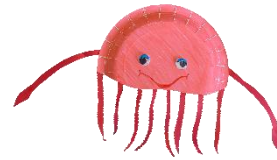


PAPER PLATE SQUID



You need:

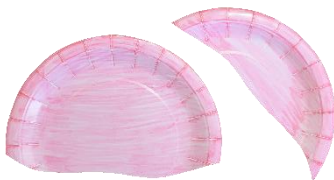
- 1 white paper plate
- Texta colours, paints or crayons
- Scissors
- 1 sheet coloured paper
- Scissors
- 2 eyes
- Glue



Note: for plates with a shiny side, texta colours may remain wet. A tissue can be used to wipe off the excess texta.

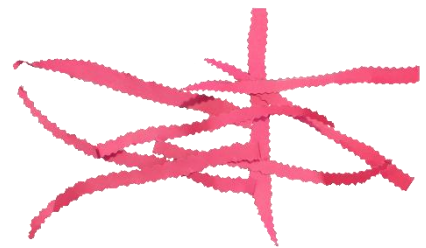
Steps:

1. Colour the plate on both sides.



2. Draw a wavy line across the top third of the plate. Cut along the line.

3. From the paper, cut 8 arms.

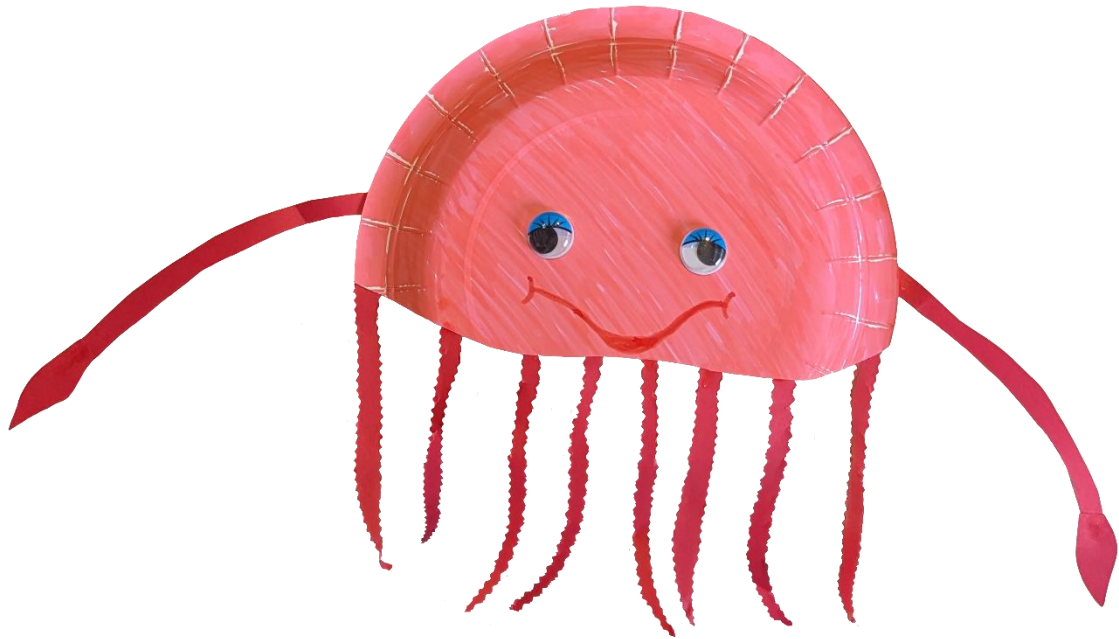


4. Cut 2 longer strips and two club like pieces. These are the feeding tentacles.

5. Glue on the arms and tentacles.



6. Draw a mouth and glue on the eyes.



ADDITIONAL IDEA

Finger paint dots on the arms to create suckers,
