Susea is a retired classroom teacher who majored in English and Children's Literature, and spent 23 years making literacy learning a joyful adventure for her young students. Her favourite time of day was always settling in with a book or two, inviting children to step quietly into the rich and magical world of story.

Writing has been a constant thread throughout Susea's life. More than a decade ago, she and her husband set sail on an around-the-world adventure, with Susea recording their travels on her sailing blog. As the miles slipped past beneath the hull and the stories gathered, notes and

ideas for language-rich children's picture books began to take shape.

Today, Susea shares her love of language, sailing, and the sea with readers young and old, through the eyes of a big blue boat and a young girl — its Captain.

While Susea loves writing, her favourite part of being an author is meeting students. Each year she runs Autumn and Spring author tours, working with students from Preschool to Year 6.



Beloved by educators and families alike, *A Big Blue Boat* supports early learning skills while delivering a fun-filled sailing adventure that will have children asking to read it again and again.




'A simple title for a book that delivers a lot of value in a picture book. The author employs rhyme, alliteration, onomatopoeia, descriptive adjectives, and sentence building to offer a host of learning opportunities.

The words are associated with the colours that represent them, each page adds more text so that as the book unfolds readers repeat and reinforce the learning. At the end of the book of glossary is included to remind young readers exactly what those 'hard words' mean.

The female captain is a role model for young girls unaccustomed to seeing females heading up the captain's job. This book is one that will be read over and over, each time reinforcing and building upon the learning that has already taken place. Highly recommended for parents, teachers, and librarians who work with children'

A Day on the Brine



With the wind in her hair and salt tickling her nose, the hungry Captain sets her line — only to discover the sea is full of surprises. From the orange-red blush of sunrise to burnished sunset, the sea begins to share its secrets. Albatross glide on wide, whispering wings, and whales roll and splash in the deep, dappled brine. All around her, the ocean hums: busy, breathing, alive.

Out here, life moves like the tide - in and out, ebb and flow; a gentle reminder that everything has its rhythm.

Brought to life by Emma Stuart's stunning illustrations, this magical rhyming tale captures the wonder of a day on the water.

Set along the wild west coast of Australia, this award-winning sequel to *A Big Blue Boat* is perfect for anyone who loves boats, sea creatures, and that delicious, salty stretch of endless blue.



'... this tale speaks to the interconnectedness of life on the ocean and the quiet magic of the sea.

Right from the start, I was pulled in by the rhythm. The repeated structure "And what do you think she sees?" makes it feel like a lullaby, or a chant you'd say to a child while swaying on a boat. It's simple, but it works. I especially loved the line about the "squid pink and shy" who "peeks at the sky." That moment stuck with me, there's something so soft and endearing about it. It's playful but also poetic.

The writing isn't trying to be clever. It's honest and kind. There's a real respect for the sea here, and that shines through the gentle language and Emma Stuart's dreamy illustrations. I found myself lingering on the page with the "whale large and grey" coming up for a play. That spread, both in words and visuals, felt alive. There's no heavy lesson being pushed, but you still get this sense of awe for marine life and the beauty of slowing down to look at the world.

One thing I appreciated deeply is the circular nature of the story. It begins and ends with the big blue boat, creating a feeling of coming home, of completing a cycle. The moon watching the boat and captain at the end made me smile. It's subtle, but it tugs at something warm in you. It reminded me of how, as a kid, I'd imagine the moon following me on car rides home. Also, the glossary and activities at the end are a nice bonus, educational without being dry, and great for curious young readers. ...'

For Teachers

I email you a copy of the PDF Preschool Resource Pack and A Book Discussion PDF prior to my visit. These complement the book, and contain activities and ideas for an A Big blue Boat theme.

The Visit

In addition to sharing my book with the students, my visit is an interactive session that introduces them to the adventure that led to my writing of the 'A Big Blue Boat' books.



- The use of a map and imagery that introduces students to a sailing journey where they learn about rare and extinct animals, ocean life, and the life people on remote islands lead. Nursery Rhymes and songs adapted to the A Big Blue Boat theme are incorporated.
- The reading which includes learning the actions for the story and parts of a boat.
- Students get to be the captain and the animals as I read and can join in if they know the words.

- Students make a boat and receive a colouring activity and bookmark.
- Students are encouraged to ask questions and make comments throughout the session.
- All activity materials are provided by the author.



During the sessions, I also work in with regular eating breaks.

Materials Provided by the Pre-School

- Pencils, textas or crayons for the children to use.

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For Parents and Staff Members

I offer pre-schools the opportunity to provide for parents and staff members, a complimentary 1-hour session where I introduce them to the journey that led to the writing of the A Big Blue Boat books.

The books will be available for purchase after the session.

This can be held before or after pre-school hours.

For Pre-Schools

Prior to the visit, the information on how to order from Susea’s website will be provided for your preschool to share with parents and staff who wish to order their copies.

The author will deliver the signed purchased books in bulk on arrival.

Recently, I had the pleasure of attending a ‘story time’ presentation by author, Susea Spray, about her beautiful picture book, *A Big Blue Boat*.

Susea used to be a teacher and it shows. Her presentation was engaging from the start. She spoke to each child like they were the only one there and varied her information and her questions to suit the audience. There was a really effective blend of presentation styles –lecture-style (where Susea talked about the different parts of a boat), questions to the audience, personal anecdotes, singing, interactive components and a story reading. Susea also incorporated large visuals, including enlarged pictures from the book so everyone could see.

What impressed me the most was Susea’s ability to tailor her presentation to the interests of the audience and to keep them fully engaged for a full 40 minutes – even the youngest listeners. There was something for everyone in Susea’s presentation – from the youngest children (pre-primary) through to Year 6, and adults.

I have attended many book launches, workshops and readings by children’s authors over the years, and have to say that Susea Spray’s presentation ranks right up the top. If I was still teaching, I would be more than happy to have Susea present to all grade levels, from Preschool and Kindergarten through to Year 6.






My husband and I first arrived in Port Macquarie when we sailed in on our boat in November 2020. Since then, it's become our home away from home and holds a special place in our hearts.


A Big Blue Boat Christmas Story
