

ALFOIL ART

You Need

Wool (8 ply+) or string

Child safe aquadear glue

Alfoil (larger than size of cardboard)

Permanent markers/highlighters/textas

Note: Permanent Markers dry faster. Wool is more pliable.

Instructions

Cut out the shape and paste it on card board.

(Older children may choose to add additions:

i.e. sea grass)



Glue string or wool along the outline of the shape/s.

Allow to dry.



Spread the glue all over the cardboard and wool.

Immediately place the alfoil on top.



Starting in the centre, gently press the alfoil, shaping it around the wool or string.

Allow to dry.



Use the textas to colour.

Note: It's possible to use a darker colour to outline (see sea grass on LH side, mouth and fin areas) .

I personally prefer to let the uncoated alfoil provide the outline for me.



Note: Templates of varying difficulties can be found on the following pages.

Goggle eyes can be added on later, as can whiskers for the dugong and features such as scales, eyes and finger separation for the mermaids.
